Twyford Parish Council Highways Meeting Notes

1. Welcome.

- 3. Village Centre Infrastructure To discuss the possibility of changes to the current road structure. Mr C Wickenden gave an overview of this agenda item.

 Discussion points as follows:
 - **3.1 Stanlake Lane bridge Reroute traffic from centre.** Item within Mr R Sunley's document. To be discussed following the review of the document.
 - **3.2 Heavy Goods Vehicle ban.** Item within Mr R Sunley's document. To be discussed following the review of the document.
 - **London Road making it pedestrian friendly.** Mr A Glencross confirmed that Highways would support a study being carried out but cannot commit to nor offer funds to implement any of the suggestions.
 - 3.4 Parking facilities Need for increase. A curb-side survey has been completed and is going through analysis Results due within 4-6 weeks. Highways will then be looking to develop a Parking Management Plan for Twyford with a possible bus interchange at Twyford Station. Carried forward for further discussion.

- **4.1 London Road Outstanding.** Mr M Heath to chase installation date.
- **4.2 Heritage Sign.** Mr M Heath advised that the sign has been disposed of. Mrs L Povey to send photos of the sign with the view of it being replaced.
- **Twyford/Hurst border Can Cuincy be added?** Mr M Heath to send through costings of a new sign for the Parish Council to consider.
- **5. Streetlamps.** Mr A Glencross confirmed receipt of the collective letter from the Town & Parish Councils requesting WBC's consideration in taking over non-WBC streetlamps and is putting together a report. Carried forward.
- **6. Hanging Baskets.** Assistant Clerk advised that written confirmation allowing the erection of baskets on lampposts throughout the village providing an official supplier is used has not been received. Mr A Glencross to chase Dave Halley.
- 7. Ideas/Discussion on how to make the village more pedestrian friendly (Refer to item 3.3). Notes can be found under item 3.3.
- 8. Speed Device (Hurst Road/Waltham Road). Mr M Heath to obtain a revised installation date.
- **9.** Blanket 20MPH through Village To discuss suitable roads. Forms part of item 3. To be discussed at the next meeting.
- **10. Weight Limit through Village (Refer to item 3.2).** Notes can be found under item 3.2.

- **11. Safe Route to School/Pedestrian Crossing (Wargrave Road).** The contractor is due to undertake surveys next week. Two locations are being focused on in Wargrave Road, south of Amberley Drive and north of Longfield Road.
- **12. A4 Speeding/Safe Route.** Meeting with the new traffic management liaison officer from TVP has taken place. Investigations on the A4 to commence to ensure consistency in the speed limits. Mr M Heath to investigate operating a temporary or a reduced speed limit passed The Piggott School.
- 13. Potential Bridge Farm Development Impact. Carried forward.
- 14. Keep Clear Signs.
 - 14.1 Wargrave Road/Utilities Road (W2122993). This has now been actioned. Noted.
 - **Section near Miles & Daughters (Needs re-doing).** Mr A Glencross to confirm if this section of road forms part of the resurfacing works planned for 2022. Carried forward.
 - **Sign needs re-doing for entrance at the side of Hunt & Nash.** Mr A Glencross to confirm if this section of road forms part of the resurfacing works planned for 2022. Carried forward.
- 15. Parking on pavements & verges.
 - **Longfield Road with Hilltop Road Junction.** Carried forward.
- 16. Integrated Travel. Carried forward.
- 17. Air Quality Banner Requires removing. Carried forward.
- 18. Hurst Road Fencing next to Gas Lane (contradicting actions). Carried forward.
- **19. Electric Hook-Ups** Mr A Glencross confirmed that there are 70 EV Charging Points within the Borough being considered Update to be provided at the next meeting. Mrs L Povey to forward any suggested locations within Twyford to Mr A Glencross for consideration. Item carried forward.
